The latest UK government statistics indicate that there has been an alarming rise in households experiencing fuel poverty. The figure now stands at 14.4%.

For Suffolk this indicates that the county now has 100,000 people living in fuel poverty this winter.

If you are in receipt of a non means tested government Winter Fuel Payment or are able to make a donation, then please give to the Surviving Winter Appeal. Our partners at Citizens Advice all over the County will then swiftly distribute your gift to heat the home of somebody else in Suffolk who is not able to make ends meet. By working together, we have already kept many thousands of people safe and warm in our local communities.

The sad reality is, this winter will prove even harder for many more people in our local communities. As the high cost of living continues, your donation will do so much more than simply heat a home. For local families and individuals of all ages, living in cold conditions poses a serious threat to both physical and mental wellbeing. It can cause damage to family life and the future prospects of our young people.
